Key Elements

- It's all about having fun and being social!
- Players play against others of the same ability, gender, and generally, the same age.
- No elimination. Win or lose, players get to keep playing.
- Matches will be played indoors on courts 2-4.

Division Play

- **Division**: Women's 3.0/3.5 Doubles
- **NTRP Rating**: Minimum 3.0; maximum 3.5. Each player will use her most current NTRP computer rating on file in USTA'S TennisLink.
- **Team Format:** 2-3 players per team.
- Players: All players (including alternates and subs) must have the Ensworth Priority Pass.
- **Subs:** You can send no more than 2 subs during the 8-week period. Only subs with above NTRP ratings are permitted to play. Subs must have the Ensworth Priority Pass to play.
- **Court Time**: 1.5 hours; Match ends after 1.5 hours regardless of score.
- **Defaults:** Any player who is not on the court within 15 minutes of the scheduled start time is in default and the match will beconceded to the opposing team.
- Match Balls: Each team brings new balls; winning team gets unused can for next match

Match Scoring

- **Match format**: Best 2 out 3 sets, with a set tiebreak (first to 7 by 2) used at 6 games all. In the event of split sets, we will play a match tiebreak (first to 10 by 2).
- **Match duration**: Match ends after 1 1/2 hours regardless of score.
- **Scoring**: Team gets one point for each set won; one point for each game won; one point for winning tiebreak. Match score for defaults should be recorded as 6-0, 6-0.
- **Schedule of matches:** Will be distributed via email to players and will be posted on the Ensworth Tennis Center lobby board on the day of match.
- Match scores: <u>Winning team</u> records scores on scoresheet posted on lobby board <u>immediately</u> after match.
