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Key Elements

- It is all about having fun and being social!
- Players play against others of the same ability, gender, and generally, the same age.
- No elimination. Win or lose, players get to keep playing.
- Matches will be played indoors

Division Play

- **Division**: Women's Singles
- **NTRP Rating**: Minimum 3.0; maximum 3.5 NTRP. Each player will use her most current NTRP computer rating on file in USTA's TennisLink.
- **Team Format:** 1-2 players per team.
- **Team Subs:** Subs with the above NTRP ratings are permitted; no prior notification is required to be given to the coordinator. You can send no more than 2 subs during the 6-week period.
- **Court Time**: Court time ends promptly at 1.5 hours regardless of score.
- **Defaults:** Any player who is not on the court within 15 minutes of the scheduled start time is in default and match will be conceded to opposing team.
- Match Balls: Each team brings new balls; the winning team gets an unused can for next match.

Match Scoring

- **Match format**: Best 2 out 3 sets, with a set tiebreak (first to 7 by 2) used at 6 games all. In the event of split sets, we will play a match tiebreak (first to 10 by 2).
- Match duration: Match ends promptly at 1.5 hours regardless of score. (12:00 to 1:30 or 1:30 to 3:00)
- **Scoring**: Team gets one point for each set won; one point for each game won; one point for winning tiebreak. Defaulted match score should be recorded as 6-0, 6-0.
- **Schedule of matches:** Will be distributed via email to players and will be posted on the Ensworth Tennis Center lobby board on day of the match.
- Match scores: Winning team records scores on scoresheet posted on lobby board immediately after match.
- **Team standings:** Coordinator will distribute team standings via email weekly.

Winner – Gets \$1 million! No just kidding! Winning team gets bragging rights and player prize.
